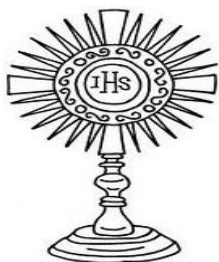

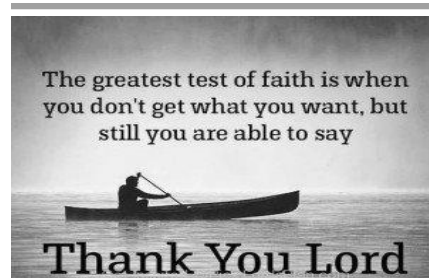
Online Credit Card Donations
