Legion of Mary

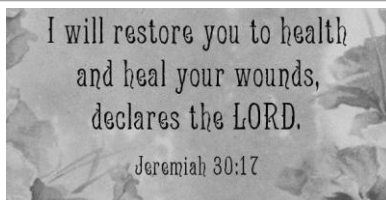
The legion of Mary is sponsoring a

early in the process and you will
avoid disappointment and stress at
the time when applications are to
be submitted.
