Registration for Junior Kindergarten (September 2019) at St. Bruno/St. Raymond Catholic School will begin on **Wednesday, January 16th, 2019 at 10:00 am.**

An extended registration session will also take place on **Thursday, January 24th from 4:30 pm to 6:30 p.m.** As part of the registration process, a meeting will be scheduled on the electronic application or in person at the school. During the meeting, the following original documentation is required for your child during registration: **Baptismal Certificate, Birth Certificate and/or Passport, Immunization Record, Proof of Residence within school catchment boundary, Immigration papers if not born in Canada, and Application for Direction of School support.**

Registration will NOT be deemed complete until all necessary documentation is on file with the school.
