FCN sponsors 2500 children and college students. They have been responsible for building several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. They provide free medical check-ups and medicine to thousands of needy people and children. 800 children born with Cleft Lip and Cleft Palate are helped with free corrective surgeries in the past 5 years.
