These rites are accompanied by a catechetical process which educates those who are becoming Catholic in the teachings of Christ and the traditions of the Church that He established to continue His mission and spread the Good News.

~Here at St. Peter's those who wish to become Catholic are invited to begin attending Mass in our parish community each Sunday. The R.C.I.A. at St. Peter's will begin in September. The group will meet throughout the length of the school year. 
