Heavens Declare the Glory of God: How Faith Illuminates Philosophy and Science –Fr. Peter Turrone

Science and philosophy are necessary disciplines to help us understand the universe we inhabit. However, they alone do not provide an adequate understanding of ultimate meaning and purpose that religion alone can provide. Using the analogy of mountain, Fr Turrone will provide a framework grounded in our Catholic faith for discerning both the usefulness and limitations of both science and philosophy. Thereafter, he will reflect upon how all of this knowledge is meant to shape our lives for the better.

Fr. Peter Turrone Graduated with a PhD in Medical Science and Neuroscience from the University of Toronto in the area of psychiatry. Entered Consolata Missionary Institute seminary immediately upon graduating. After completing a Philosophy degree was sent to Rome for theological studies at Urbaniana University. Thereafter, ministered in the Gobi Desert of Mongolia for three years. Upon returning to Canada, remained in Toronto and worked in various parishes, including The Newman Centre Catholic Mission at U of T. Current Pastor of Holy Rosary Parish. He is a Benedictine Oblate novice with Saint Vincent Archabbey in Latrobe, Pennsylvania.
